Rav-Kav is a rechargeable travelcard used on all means of public transport in Israel. You must have a Rav-Kav card when using:



Buses



Trains



The light rail
(Jerusalem)



Metronit
(Haifa)

The cost of purchasing the Rav-Kav card itself is 5 NIS

* Make sure to charge your Rav-Kav card before boarding public transport

WHERE TO CHARGE A RAV-KAV CARD?

- < Tel Aviv Tourist Info Centers >>
- < Al HaKav Service Centers >>
- < At marked convenience stores and kiosks around the city >
- < At 'Tel-O-Fun' bike stations in Tel Aviv >
- < At selected ATMs (Casponet) >

Please Validate your Rav-Kav card on the start of every journey

To validate, place your card on the front of the electronic reader. One validation allows you free passage for 90 min within the city.
